## Helpful Terms

### Assisted Living Facility

A facility licensed by the state of California to provide a living arrangement for people with special needs, especially seniors with disabilities. It provides help with everyday tasks such as bathing, dressing and taking medication. The services provided may vary. The cost is not covered by medical insurance, but may be covered by long-term care insurance.

### Board and Care Home

A home licensed by the state of California to provide services such as meals, medication supervision, and assistance with bathing, dressing and eating. Most facilities are licensed for six or fewer residents, but some are larger. The cost is not covered by medical insurance.

### Housing and Urban Development (HUD)

A federal government program of low-income housing for persons who qualify.

**Placement**

A term used to describe moving a person to a care facility.

**Placement Assistance Agencies**

Agencies that assist people in locating care facilities that meet their needs.

**Shared Housing**

An option for an elderly person to share his or her home with another person in exchange for rent or services such as housekeeping, cooking, companionship, etc.

**Skilled Nursing Facility** (also Nursing Home, Convalescent Home or Rehabilitation Hospital)

An inpatient facility, licensed by the State of California, that provides 24-hour nursing services to persons in need of extended care.
