

What is Senior Care Management?

Senior Care Management is a program of the Continuing Care Department. Social workers provide long term care management assistance to at-risk members 65 and older.

Senior Care Management provides:

- Information and referrals to community services and resources including:
 - Home delivered meals
 - Transportation
 - Help at home
 - Financial programs and services
- Counseling to address health and social changes affecting daily living.
- Planning for future care needs.

Senior Care Calls - friendly volunteer phone calls on a regular basis

Caregiver Support Groups – for anyone providing care for an ill or elderly person. The group provides a safe and caring place to share feelings and concerns along with options and solutions for common problems. Groups are led by a social worker and a nurse. There is no charge.

Anyone may refer a Kaiser Permanente member for Senior Care Management. Referrals are screened by the Program Services Coordinator, a Social Worker or the RN Case Manager.
